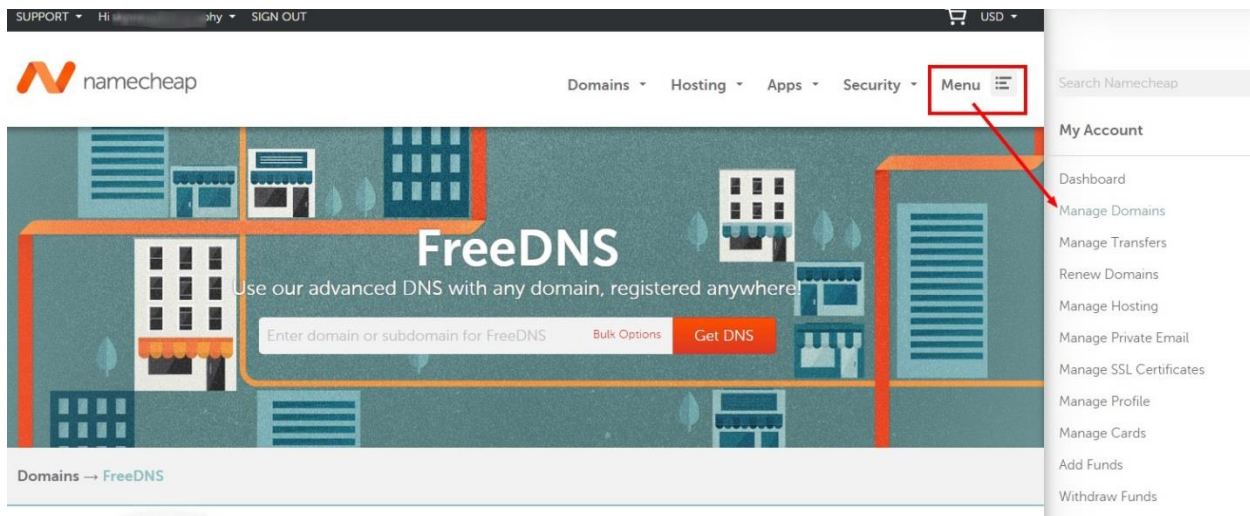


NameCheap Domain Instructions PDF

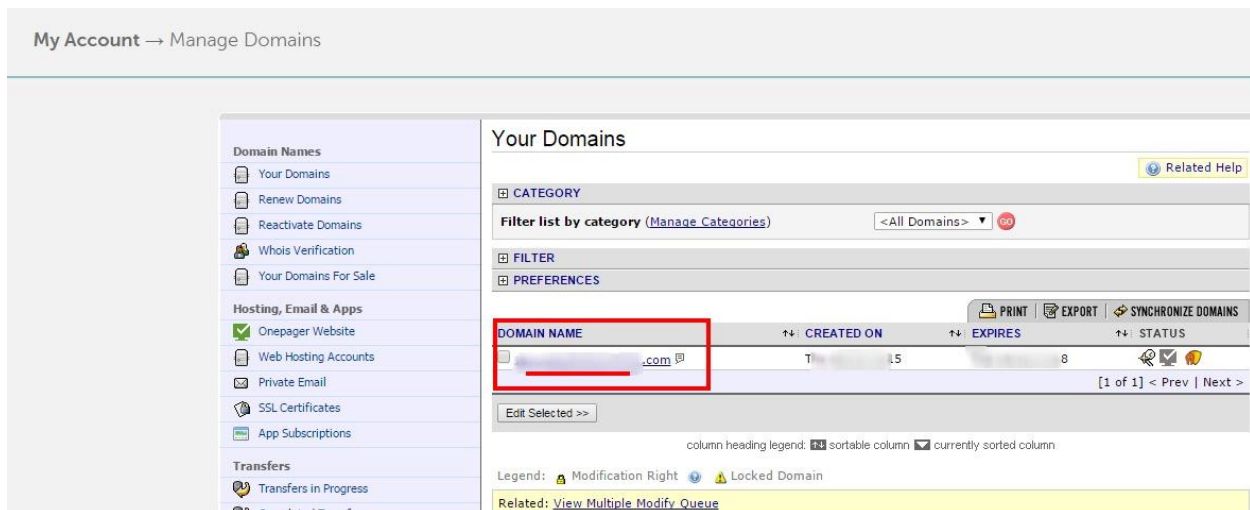
To change the A record at NameCheap.com:

1. Go to <https://manage.www.namecheap.com>
2. Log in to your NameCheap account

3. Click 'Menu' on the Dashboard and choose 'Manage Domains' from the drop down menu.




4. Click on the domain name you want to use with your Redframe site



5. On the next page, click 'All Host Records' in the menu to the left


