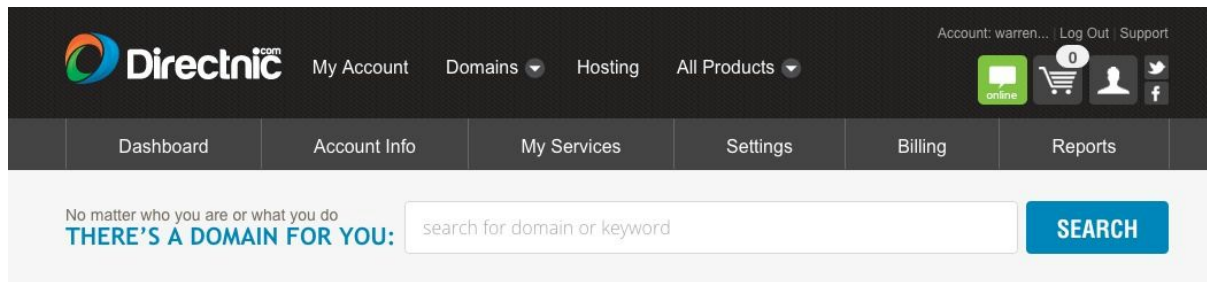

To change your nameservers at Directnic

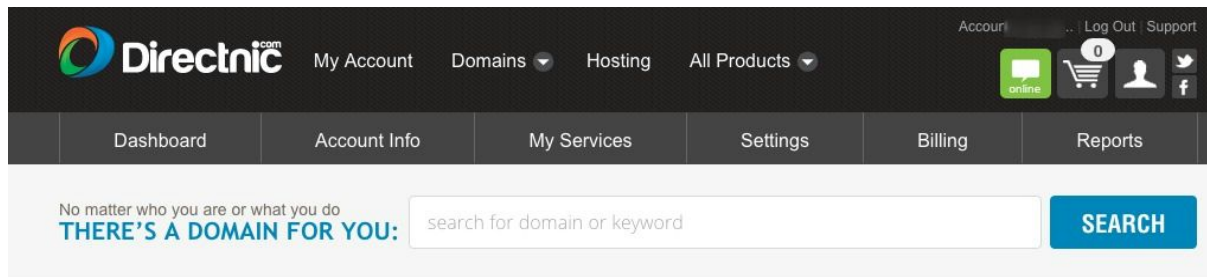
1. Go to <http://directnic.com>.
2. Log into your Directnic account.

3. Click on Domain name you want to change nameserver on.

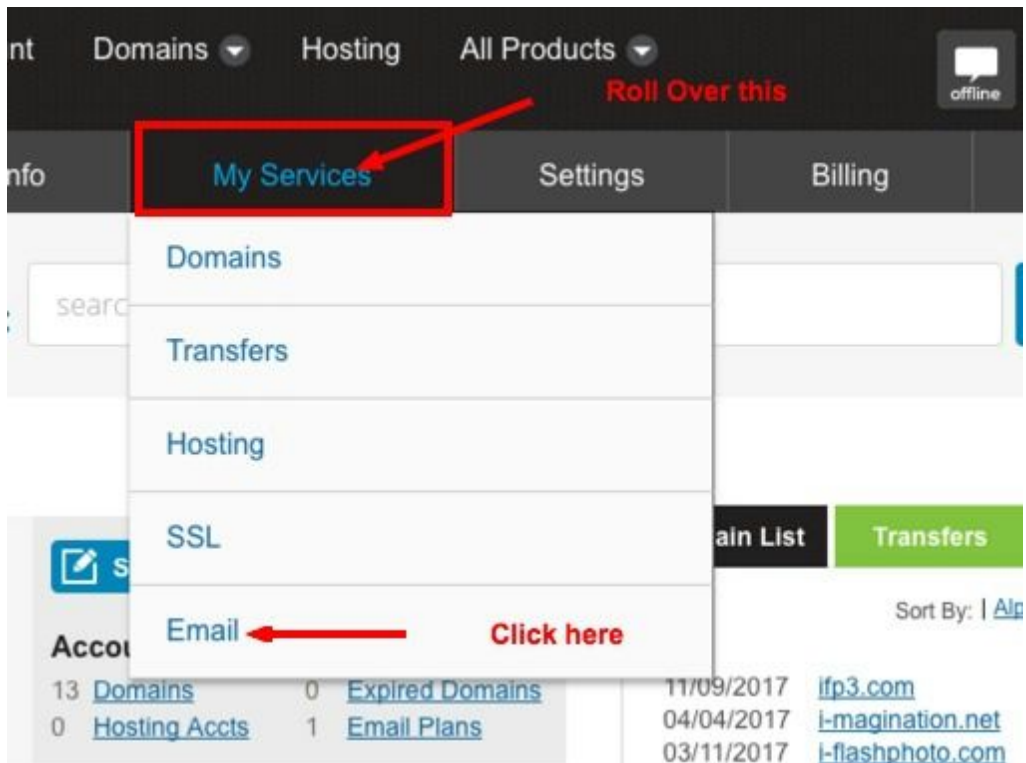

Using Email For your Website

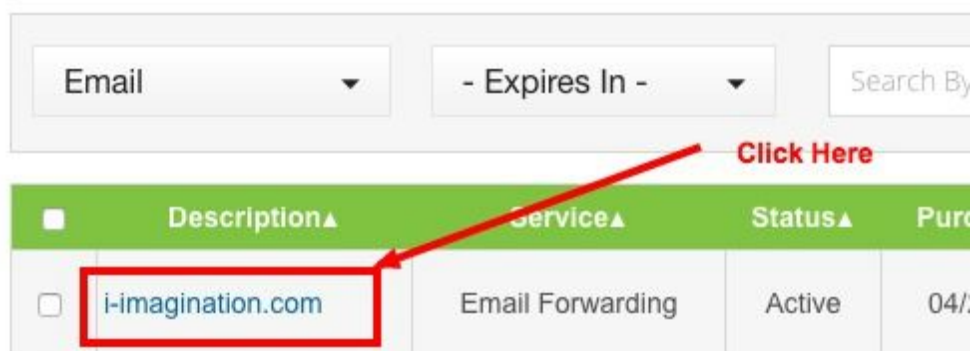
If you are using an email associated with your domain name, you will need to update the MX servers in your Redframe or ifp3 admin through the following steps:

1. Roll Over My Services and click on "Email".

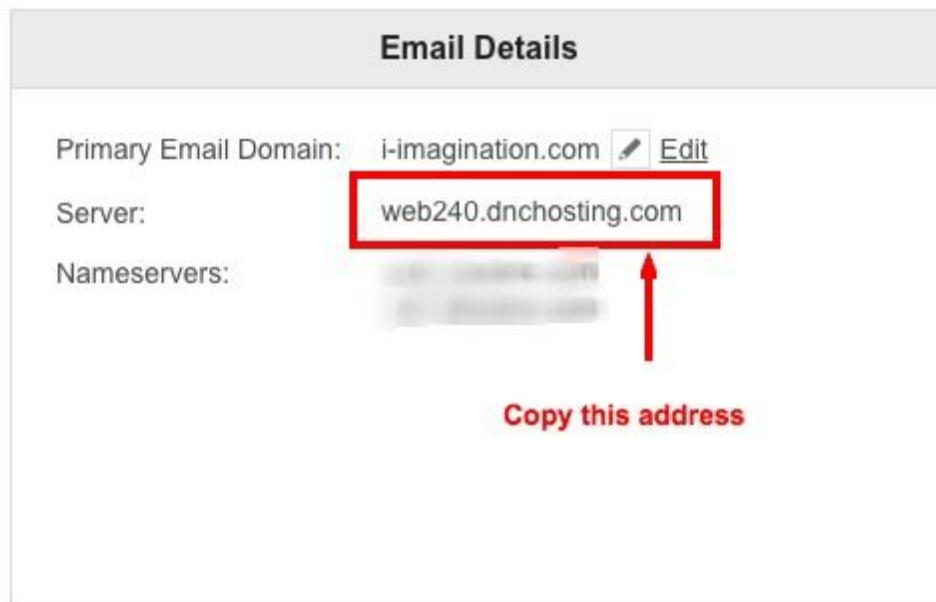


2. Choose the domain name you wish to get MX records from.
