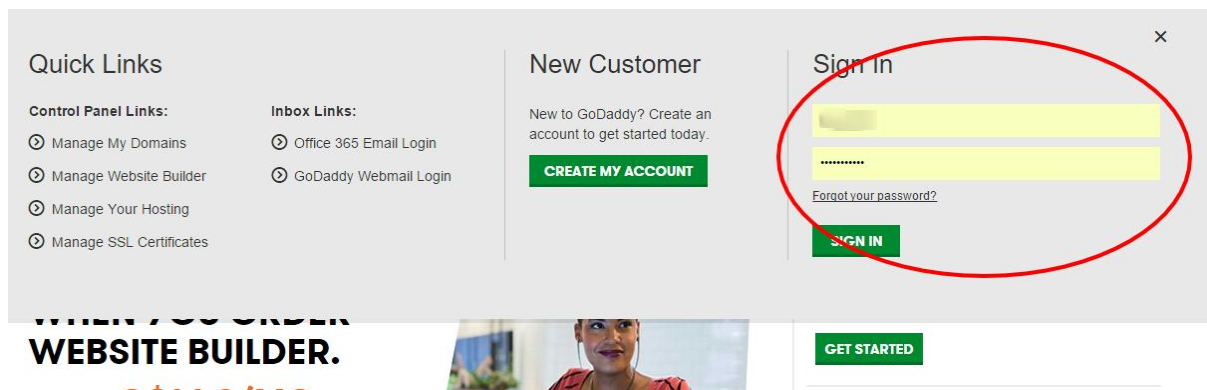

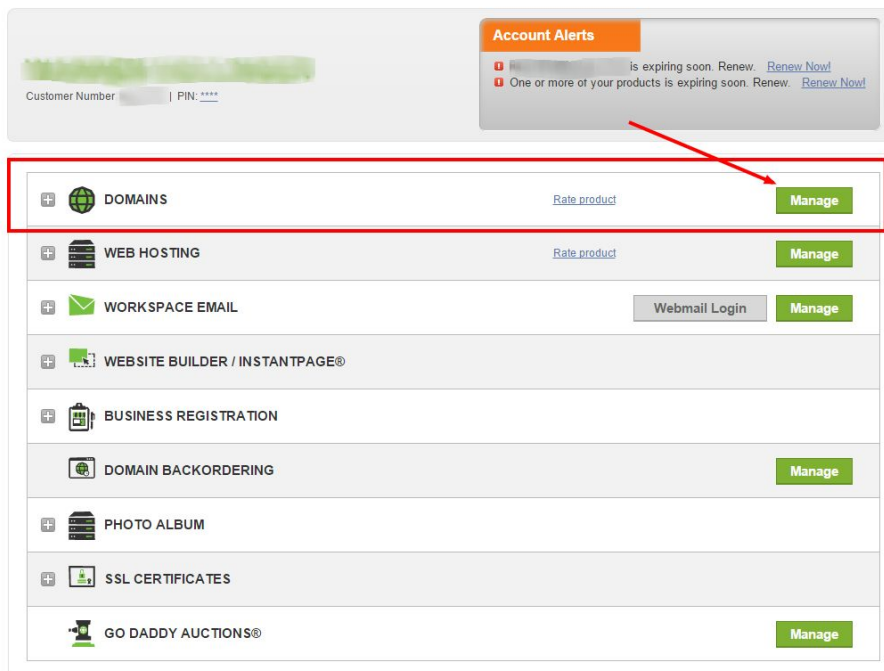
GoDaddy Domain Instructions

To change your nameservers at GoDaddy

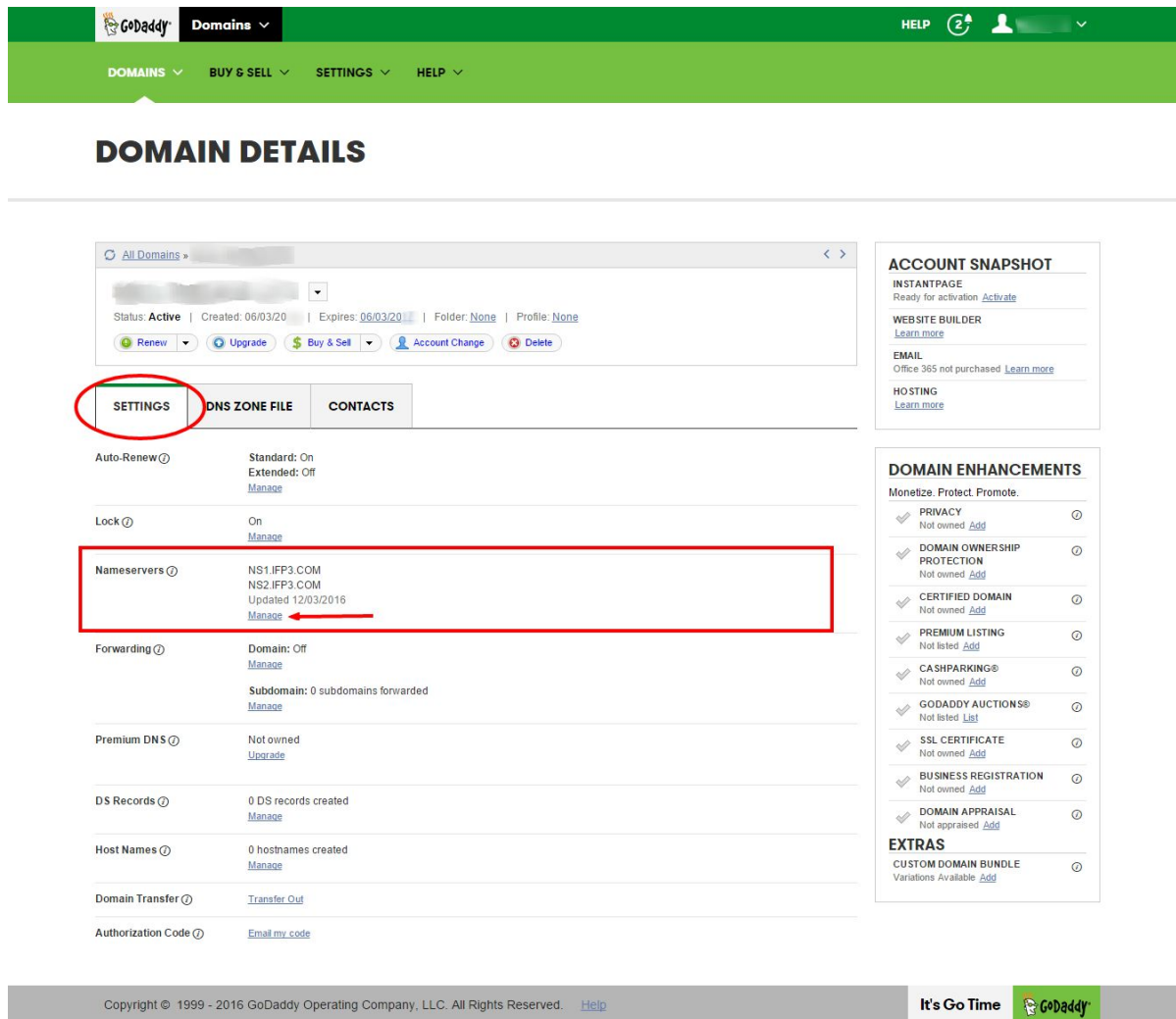
1. Go to <http://godaddy.com>
2. Log into your Godaddy account



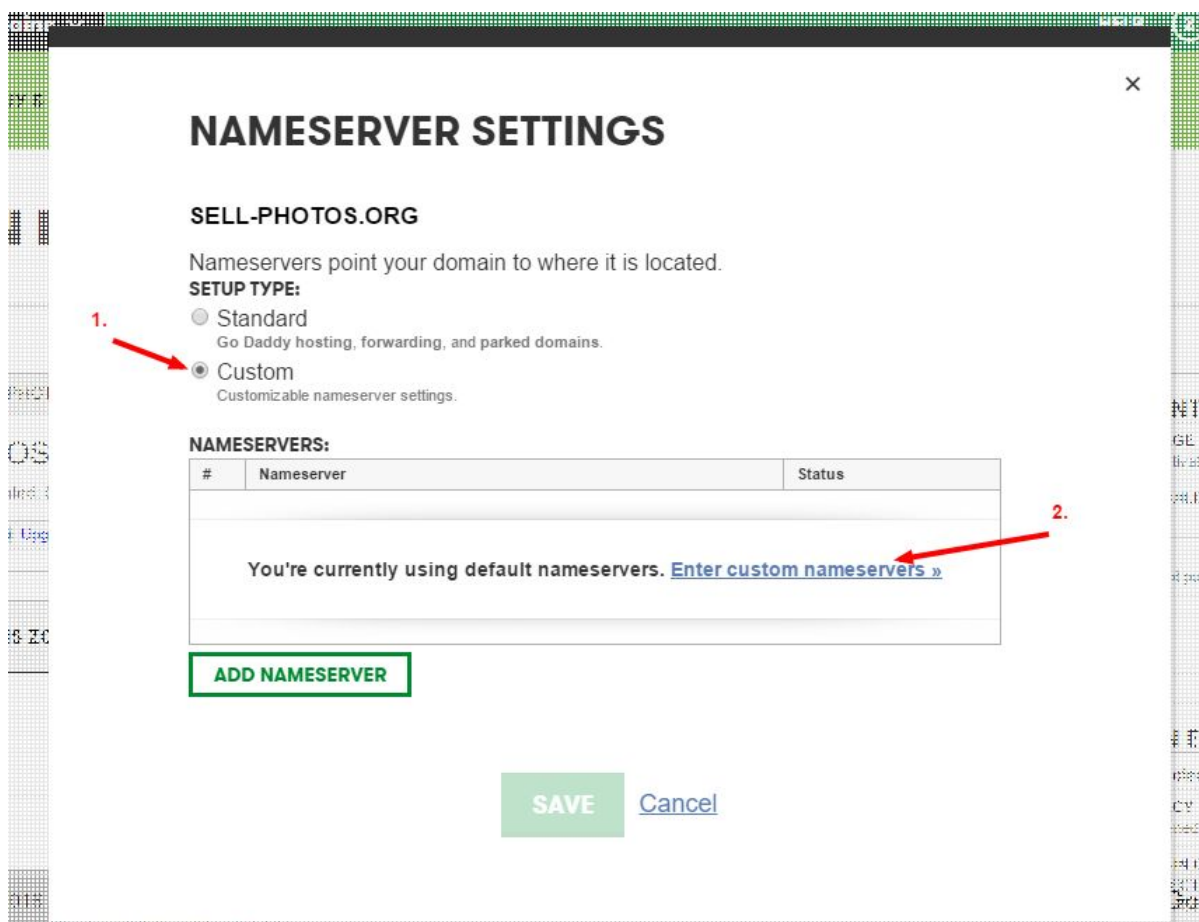
3. Click on Domains > Manage and then when the page refreshes click on the appropriate domain.



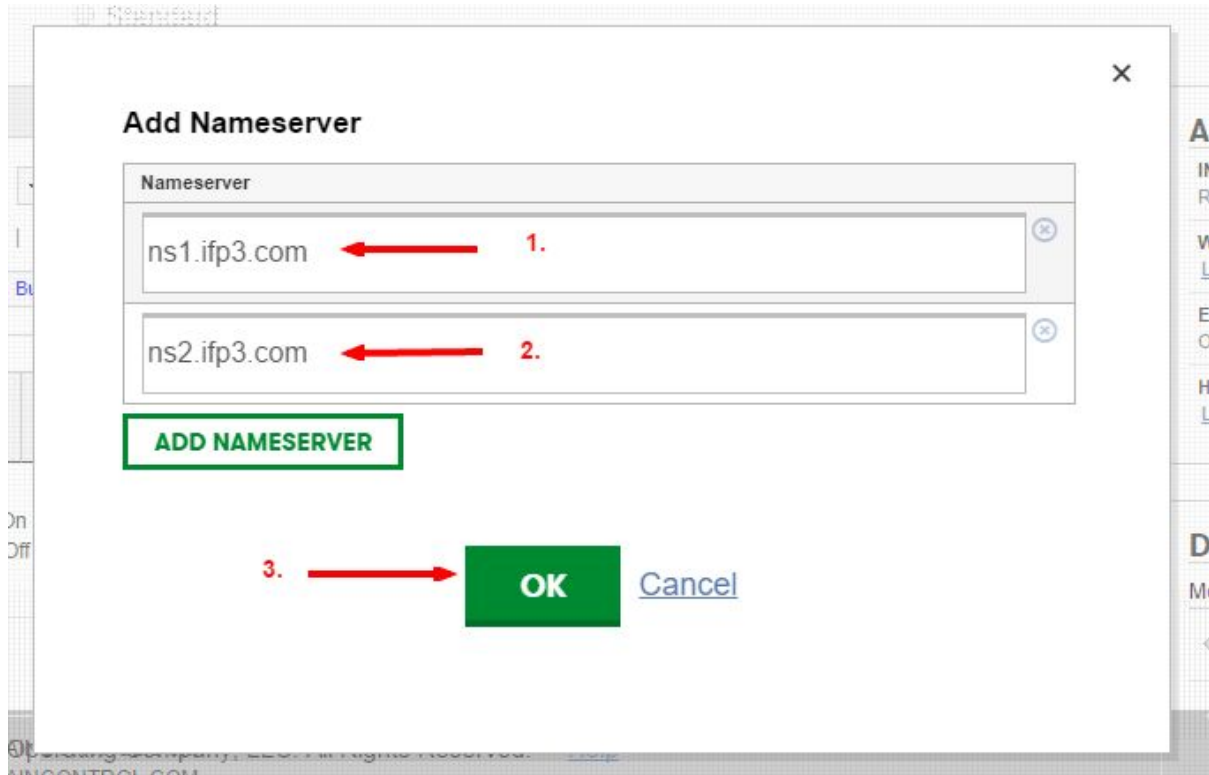
4. On the Domain Details page, click on Nameservers > Manage.



5. In the Nameserver Settings window, choose "Custom" and enter custom nameservers.



6. Enter the following into the Add Nameserver fields. **ns1.ifp3.com** and **ns2.ifp3.com**

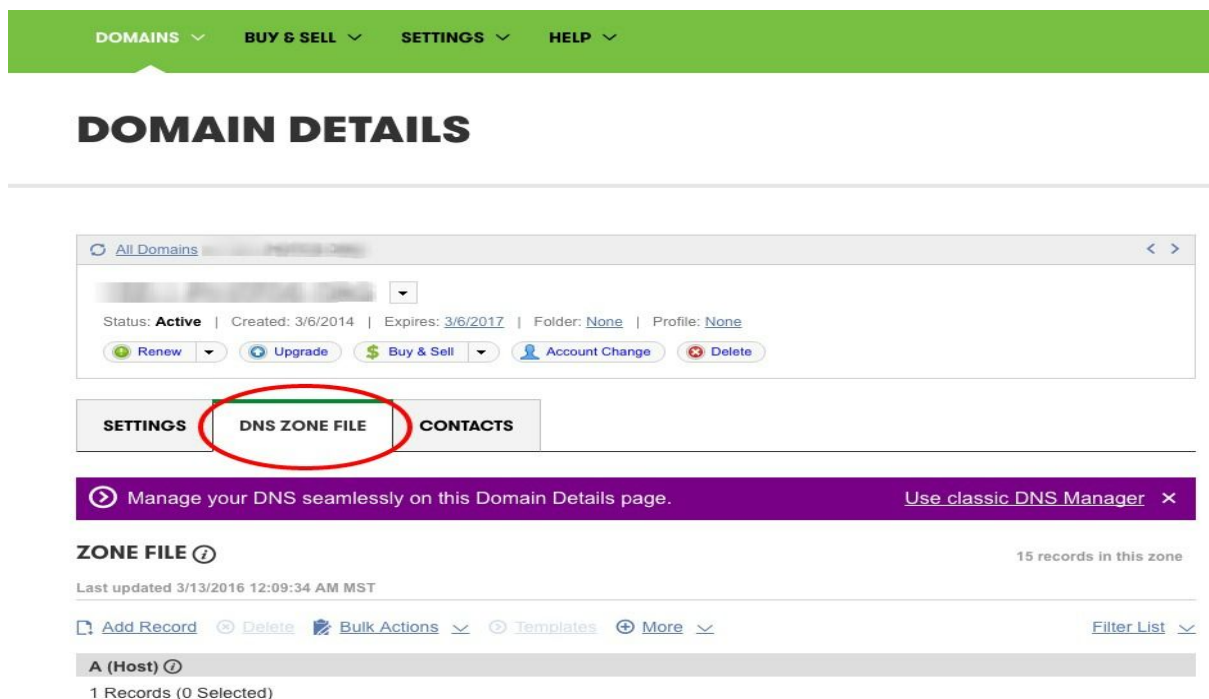


7. Notify Support that the changes have been made via the support ticket in your admin.

Using Email For your Website

1. If you are using an email associated with your domain name, you will need to update the MX servers in your Redframe or ifp3 admin through the following steps:

2. On the Domain Details page, click on “DNS Zone Files” tab



3. Scroll down this page to near the end and you will see MX records. Copy this information. You will need the server addresses and the priority numbers they associate to..
